Action	Action taken by CMS following a Hospital Price Transparency Compliance Review	The following actions have the following definitions: Met Requirements: The hospital was reviewed by CMS and no deficiencies were cited. This category includes hospitals that were found to be in compliance upon CMS' first review. Administrative Closure: Refers to the termination of compliance review activities due to reasons such as, but not limited to, a hospital has ceased operations, closed its physical location, is not subject to the HPT requirements, or has already been deemed to meet the requirements. Warning Notice: The hospital was reviewed by CMS and deficiencies were cited in a warning notice issued to the hospital. CAP Request: The hospital was reviewed by CMS and deficiencies were cited in a request for a corrective action plan (CAP) issued to the hospital. Closure Notice: CMS determined that the hospital corrected previously identified deficiencies and issued a closure notice to the hospital. CMP Notice: CMS issued a civil monetary penalty (CMP) to the hospital if the hospital failed to respond to CMS' request to submit a corrective action plan or comply with the requirements of a corrective action plan.
